### Keep your contact information current with SPCU.

It is very important to keep your current address and phone numbers updated with us. This also applies to any name changes. You may not think this is vital information, but it is and for several reasons. The number one main reason is security. You may fall prey to a potential fraud on your account. Typically, when this happens we would block your debit or credit cards you may have with us. The next step would be to follow up with you with a phone call. If your phone numbers are not updated properly we can not do so. Addresses are important due to the fact that your personal information is being sent to the address we have on file. This also affects the addresses where your debit and credit cards are mailed to .

Your debit card will not work in certain areas in Georgia due to massive fraud or their system is not compatible with our visa debit card network. Our system is up to date with visa regulations, however the merchant with Chatham County is not compatible with the network.

The cities in Georgia that are blocked from you using your debit card due to massive fraud are:

Lovejoy, Stockbridge, Fayetteville, McDonough, Douglasville, Hiram, Lithia Springs, Austell, Marietta and Smyrna.

Compatibility issues with Chatham County include: Chatham County Tag Office, DMV, Chatham County Court House or any government office that is operated by Chatham County.
